

Uniform Policy

School uniform items are available from ID School Gear, Zebbug. All students must be in full school uniform at all times, unless otherwise directed by the College's leadership team and/or teaching staff. Blazers may be removed once inside the school building, after assembly. In Senior School, students are allowed to come to school in their PE kit or tracksuit on PE days only. In Middle School students come to school in their PE kit or tracksuit also on Art days. If PE and Art lessons happen to be on the same day then students will be allowed to come to school in PE kit on the day they have Drama.

Winter

- Blazer - 1

- White T-shirts - 2

- Black Bermudas/ Shorts (Girls) - 1
- Black PE jacket - 1
- Black PE trousers - 1
- Socks (white) - 3
- White Trainers (no fancy colours) - 1



Optional Items

- Rain Jacket
- Black tank top
- White polo neck
- Black scarf
- Black hair bands

Quantities are inserted as suggested minimum requirements.

Please note that:

- All students should be dressed neatly, and come to school well groomed and bathed.
- Frayed cuffs and hems are extremely untidy. Parents must ensure that the uniform is clean and in good condition.
- Full uniform items and PE tracksuit items should not be mixed. Should you have a problem with a particular item, wear full uniform or PE kit and bring a note from your parents.
- The burgundy v-neck should not be worn with the PE kit. The black SMC tank top can be worn over the PE T-shirt or summer uniform shirt.
- The Blazer must be worn when entering and leaving the College.
- Smart black leather shoes are to be worn with the uniform. Leisure shoes and ballerina shoes must not be worn with the uniform. Black trainers with black socks may be worn with PE Kit.
- Heels should not be higher than 3.5 cm.
- Only black scarves and white polo necks are allowed in cold weather.
- No student should wear clothing that is too tight or revealing.
- The wearing of make-up and/or jewellery and rings is NOT ALLOWED
- Girls may wear one pair of earrings (studs only) on each earlobe.
- Girls' culottes should not be shorter than 8cm above the knee.
- No sunglasses may be worn except for medical reasons.
- Long hair must be pulled back and kept off the face.
- No coloured or inappropriate under vests are allowed.
- **All uniform items must be clearly labelled, in case of loss.**

Behaviour Management Regarding Uniforms

Students coming to school in the wrong item or have the appropriate item but infringe the dress code will be formally warned and their name will be listed on the noticeboard. If the student's name is listed twice on the board community service will be handed out.

Please note that:

- Whenever there is a valid reason for attending in the wrong uniform a parental note has to be shown to the supervisor, Level Leader or Form Tutor upon entry. The student needs to keep this note to present on demand.
- Whenever an item is not available from the school shop, a note stating item, size and colour, must be presented.

The school will contact parents/guardians when serious and/or repetitive infringements of the dress code occur initially through a letter sent home followed by a meeting with parents/guardians.
